Subject: Weiser Leads Bennet in Democratic Primary for Governor

Date: June 25, 2026

A new Public Policy Polling survey in Colorado finds Phil Weiser leading Michael Bennet in the Democratic primary for Governor, 45%-36%, with 19% undecided.

Weiser's advantage comes despite still having a name recognition deficit, with 65% of voters having an opinion about him compared to 80% for Bennet. Weiser is up 62-25 among voters familiar enough with him to have an opinion, while Bennet trails 48-41 even among voters familiar enough with him to have an opinion.

Weiser has an even bigger lead at 54-37 among those who have already returned their ballots. The race is much tighter at 36-34 among those who haven't returned them yet.

Weiser is winning thanks to a 62-21 advantage among younger voters. Bennet is up 43-37 with the rest of the electorate but that's not nearly enough to make up for the lopsided margin with voters under 45.

PPP interviewed 600 likely Democratic primary voters in Colorado on June 24-25, 2026.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 4.0%. 62% of interviews were conducted by text and 38% by landline.
